Momentum is building as the Greater Greenspoint Redevelopment Authority (GGRA) announces several new projects scheduled in 2009. On the heels of a project at the underpass of Interstate 45 and the North Sam Houston Parkway, dressing it up with colored columns and bright lights, these new projects add character and function to key routes for Greenspoint employees and residents.



- **Greenspoint Drive** – This project improves access and lays the groundwork for future development along the street by reconstructing it to add landscaped medians, adding new bus stops and benches, and placing utilities underground.
- **Airline Drive** , from Aldine Bender to West Road – Sidewalk improvements, new bus stops and benches, crosswalks and other street repairs are a few of the items included in this project.
- **Greens Parkway** – The entire street will be resurfaced.

In addition to these projects, Benmar Drive, Greens Road and Imperial Valley will receive new benches, bus stops and public art at some locations. For more information on the GGRA, click [here](#).

Problem Apartment to Benefit Community

The Chelsea Walk North Apartments, formerly at 15715 Wagon Rd., have been demolished to make way for a new Aldine ISD early childhood center. This project is the second agreement between the Greater Greenspoint Redevelopment Authority and Aldine ISD resulting in the demolition of neglected apartments and the construction of a new school.



“Aldine’s Bussey Elementary School, Wussow Park and CityView Park all stand in the place of what used to be unsightly, unsafe apartments,” said Sally Bradford, GGRA’s executive director. “I’m proud that the Redevelopment Authority has been able to work with stakeholders in this community to bring about meaningful changes. These properties once detracted from the area. Now they will bring enjoyment and value for generations to come,” she added.

Construction on the new school, which will be located next to Black Elementary, is expected to begin this year. In that same area, the GGRA recently completed Buckboard Park, a 5-acre parcel featuring artistic educational components geared toward young children. The park is now open to the public and a grand opening celebration is anticipated for early Spring.
